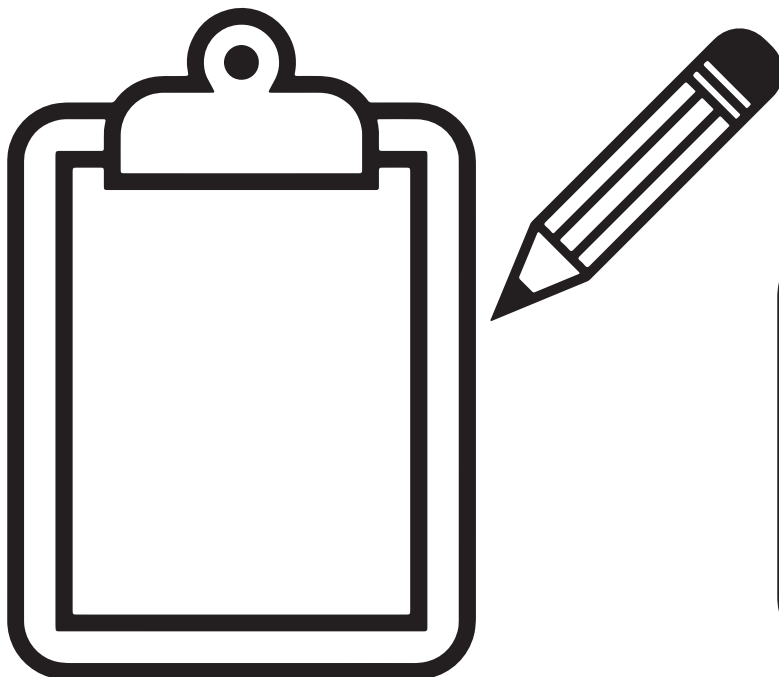
Age: All ages
